Ten years ago our church instigated a community-wide effort to spread Jesus's love by combining efforts to 1) glorify God 2) build fellowship among Christian churches and 3) help the needy. Since that time hundreds of projects have been accomplished that speak to these goals. Please plan to be a part of our efforts for 2016!

We need project managers who will form teams of workers to undertake projects such as constructing wheelchair ramps, cleaning yards and houses, and doing repairs. There will also be opportunities for folks to engage in "soft" projects such as making blankets for the Dragonfly House, delivering food, and visiting nursing homes. Everyone can find a way to help! Project managers will identify the needs that they agree to work on in mid-March. Also at that time, individuals will begin to sign up for a variety of jobs. Financial donations are welcomed and need to be in by April 1.
