She entered Union Theological Seminary in New York City where she earned a Master of Divinity. She is currently the Senior Pastor of the historic <u>Madison Avenue</u> <u>Baptist Church</u> in New York City (and the first woman in its 165 year history). Susan is a cancer survivor and speaks to groups across the country on humor and healing. Susan has been featured in *O Magazine*, the *New York Times*, on CBS, CNN and ABC.
