Dear First Baptist Church Family,

Thank you so much for your faithfulness to the Bamong People. The money that you have generously given will be used to help both the Bamong People who wish to know more about Christ and local believers who wish to know more about ministering among the Bamong. We have learned that many Bamong People are at least curious about Christ but are not willing to risk the great social pressures that would come upon them if caught publicly searching. This is where our new Media and Internet project come in. Most of our people group have smart phones and surf the web in the privacy of their own homes. We are working on

taking the scriptures that we have already translated and editing them for the web. This allows our friends to read the scriptures online in privacy. We are developing another website that will have material for those in the people group who are curious about Christ. Part of the money you have given will be used to translate appropriate materials.

Another area your gift will be sponsoring is the translating and creating material for the local believers a DVD series is done and contains a very wide array of topics for congregations wishing to learn more about the faith of our people group and how to minister to them.

We are also working toward creating our own DVD that will contain questions from local believers and responses to those questions from leaders among the Bamong People. We have gathered some questions already but need to find local believers to help with the production.

The money you have given truly is a blessing from God, and many people will be blessed because of it. Thank you once again for your faithfulness.

First Baptist Endowment Fund \$1,399,713.00 total as of February 4, 2014

As we began the New Year the church received a \$200,00 gift to the Endowment. This gift along with other gifts will provide perpetual income for the financial future of First Baptist. We are grateful for this and all gifts.

What is an Endowment exactly? An endowment is a pool of invested assets. Gifts are invested through the endowment and only the earnings are spent, never the principal. The Four Funds are: Building and Grounds, Enrichment, Missions, and Unrestricted. An endowment is a perfect way to create a lasting legacy. First Baptist remains very dependent on members to fund the Annual Operating Budget. Due to declining giving to the financial support of our church we have used the endowment to cover costs that should be covered in the Annual Operating Budget.

Members of FBC both living and deceased have contributed to the Endowment Fund. So, you may ask...How can I continue the legacy by contributing to the Endowment Fund? Of course lifetime gifts are always welcome; although some gifts are made through a deceased member's Last Will and Testament. If you have a Will, it can be as simple as contacting your attorney and asking that a Codicil be added to benefit the Endowment Fund with some potion of your estate. Another very easy and simple way to include FBC in your estate plan is to name the Endowment Fund as beneficiary of a percentage of your life insurance, IRA, 401(k) or annuity.
