The vote will be to rescind the purchase of a van and purchase at a cost of \$60,000 a 15 passenger "mini-bus" that requires no CDL license to operate. We will continue to use and maintain the church bus.

Columbaríum

Back in late 2002 the church began construction of the Columbarium. The construction included 96 Niches and each Niche could hold up to two inurnments of ashes. We also constructed on two side panels of the Columbarium 48 spaces for a Remembrance Plaque where you can have the name or names of a loved one engraved. Our Columbarium still has plenty of niches available for purchased at a cost of \$1,500 and this includes the engraving. The Remembrance Plaque can hold one or two names and the cost is \$300.
