# Martha Best Children's Center 4 Star Licensed Program for 120 Children

September 1 – August 31 is the calendar year for the Children's Center. They currently employee 24 staff and begin the new year with: Day Care 64 children: 95% full, Nursery School 78 children: 68% full, After School: 39 children 62% full. 13 children are on full or partial Scholarship at a cost of \$453.80/month. Thanks to gifts and contributions and fundraising the current deficit is \$3,254. The Center receives a grant from Smart Start for three months and hopefully for the full year.
