You have inspired me and have helped shape my soul into something so much deeper than it would be if I had not known you.

Sandra and I are not moving. She will continue her work at The Pastor's Pantry. This is our home. However, we recognize that in our staying the relationship will change. I commit myself to assisting with any and all aspects of this transition for the church. I will continue to serve with you over the next few months, with the anticipation of my full retirement starting the end of May.


