Church Security

After a few incidents over the past several weeks, the need has arisen where we need to take a closer look at security for our church building. We have been fortunate that in these incidents, there has been no forced entry, no damages to the building or equipment or nothing missing. With the consent of the Building and Grounds Committee, a few changes were recently made to our building security. We will continue to evaluate the security needs and make changes as needed. We are looking at things both when the building is open for normal business and services as well as when the building is closed.

On weekdays, please enter the building through the doors on the Hargrave Street side of the building. Press the button near the keypad to allow entry. Stop by the church office to let a staff member know where you will be and for how long you will be in the building. Try not to use the Children's Center entrance

unless there is specific business there. If you need to be in the building after normal hours, please try to notify the church office so appropriate arrangements can be made for you to use the building and ensure your safety. The safety and security of our building are paramount. Please work with us to stay safe and secure.

Hearing Assistance Devices Available for the Sanctuary

Ever since 1985, the church has maintained a hearing assistance system to help people hear services in the sanctuary. The system consists of a small FM radio transmitter located in the vestibule desk with the sound controls, plus four "vest-pocketsized" receiver units. Each receiver has an ear piece (some are earbuds; some are "ear speakers" that are not inserted into the ear canal), and there is also a volume control. The receivers can be used anywhere in the sanctuary. To borrow one for use in a service, just ask an usher. We have never had requests for more than four receivers at a time, although we have tried to make their availability known. If we find that more receivers are needed, we can acquire more units. There is no limit on how many receivers the transmitter can feed.

People who want their own receivers can purchase them. First Methodist Church and the Civic Center have the same type of system, operating on different channels, but the current-model receivers are multi-channel, and can be used with either system by selecting the correct channel.
