Next Sunday is the beginning of a three-Sunday Sermon Series on "What Does It Mean to be saved? Salvation in Three Tenses."

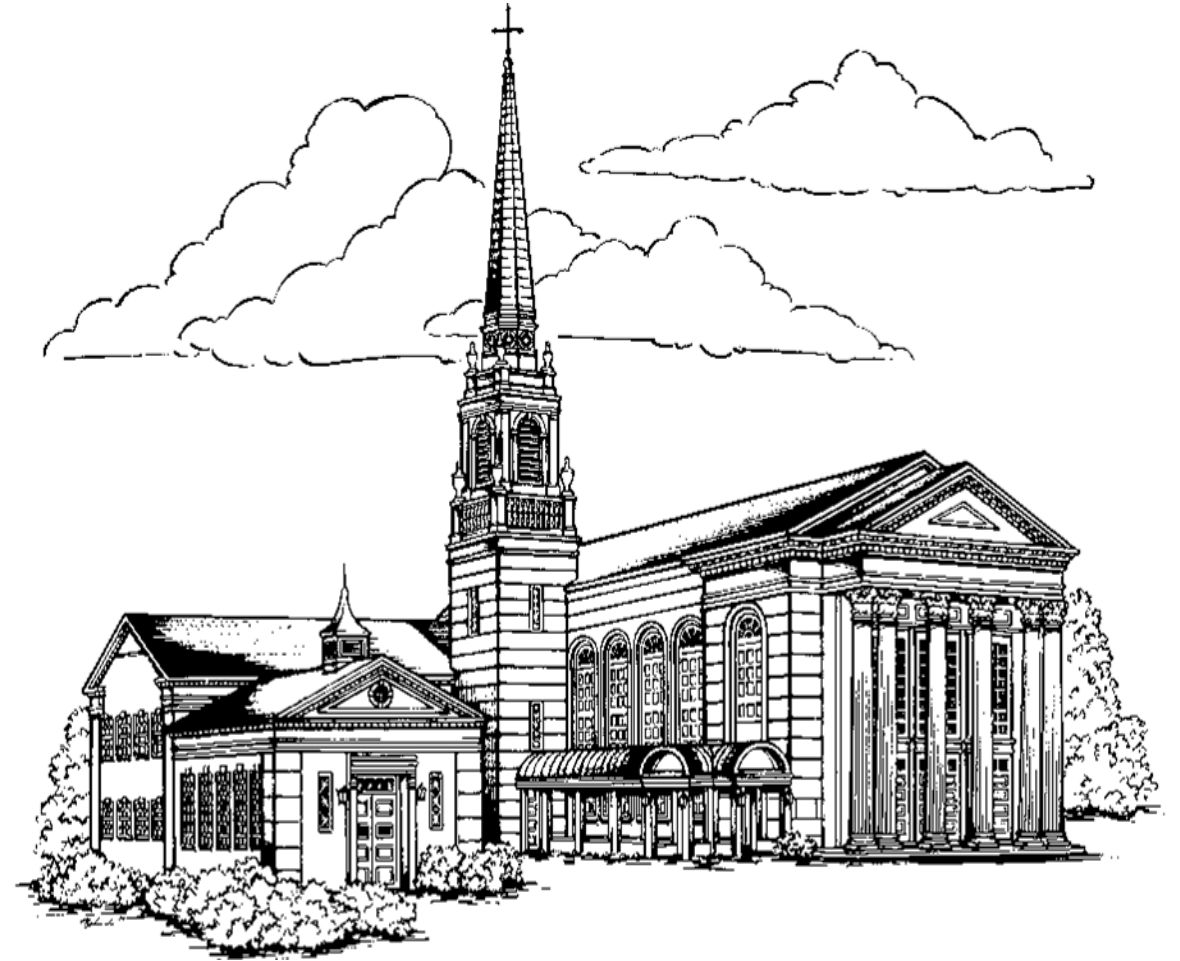
