2019 Family Life Retreat

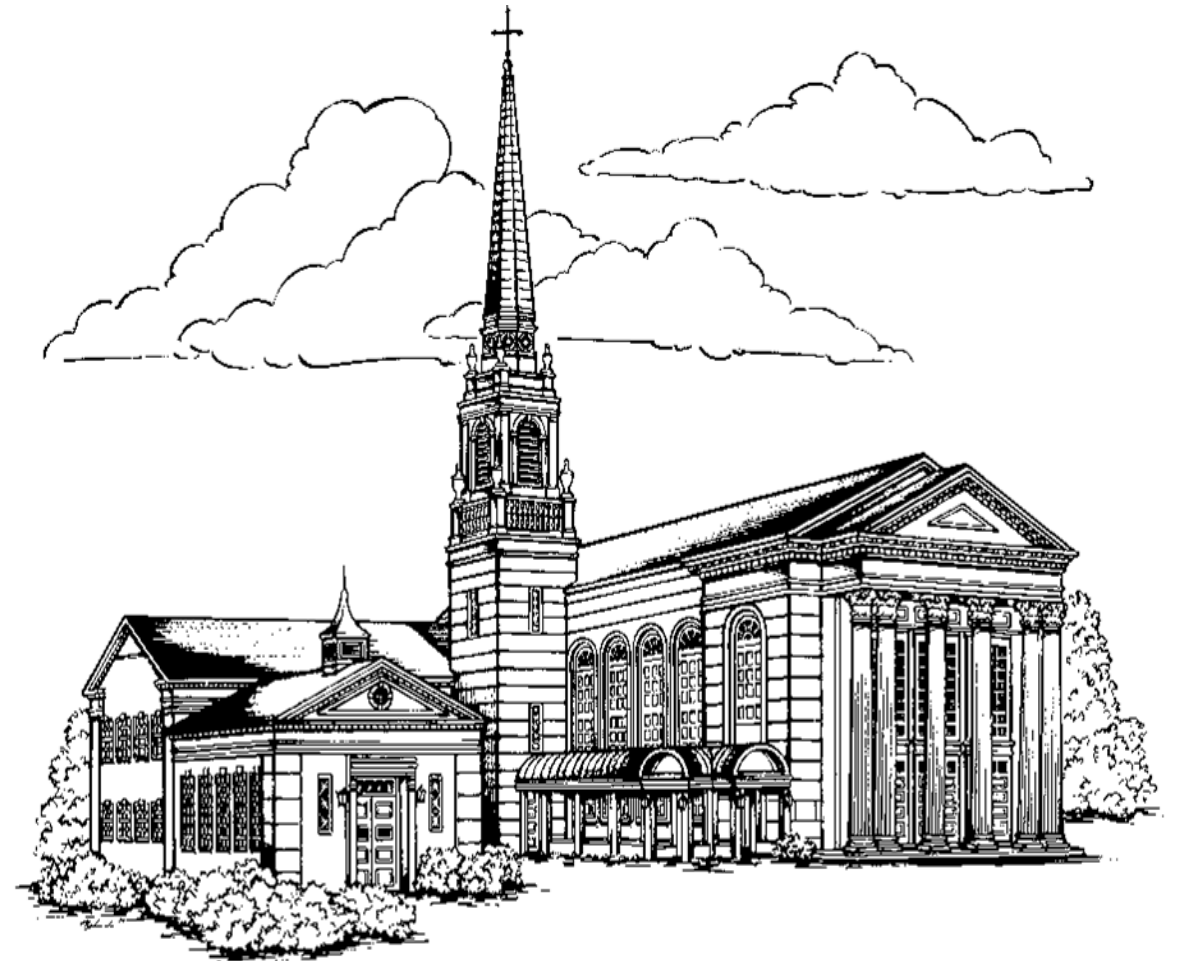
