Vacation Bible School

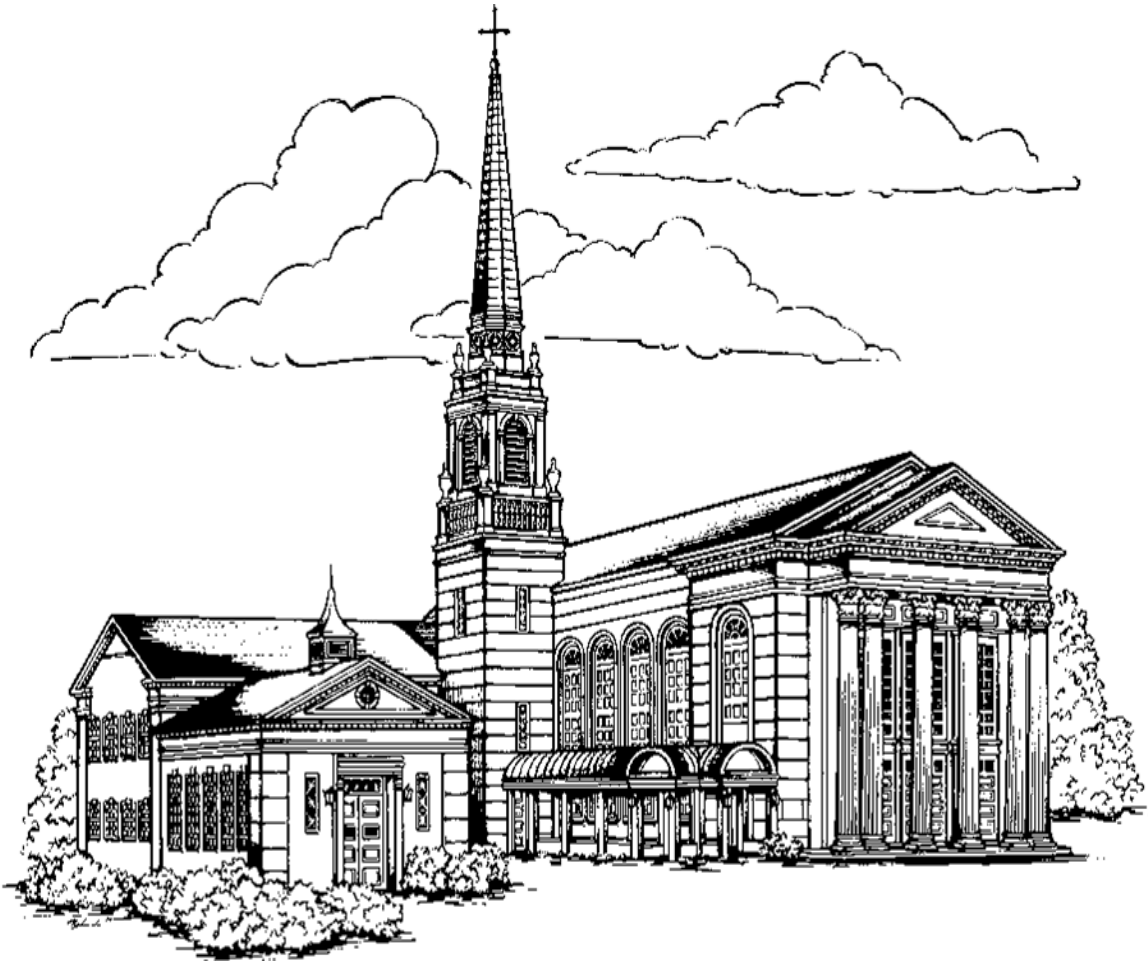
