Ray and Joyce will lead a pilgrimage to the Holy Land February 25 – March 7. 2021. Details on the trip and enrollment forms are now available in the church office.

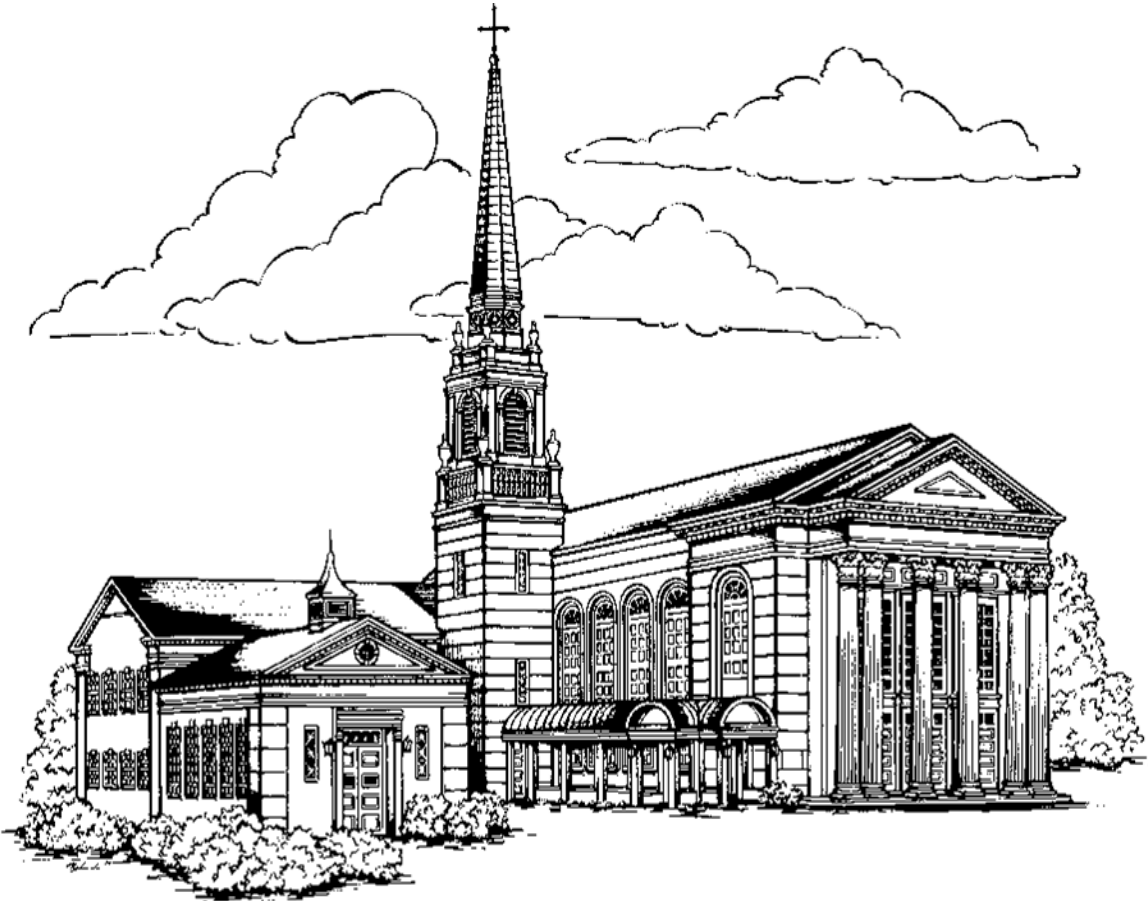
