Expenses: \$58,773.19 Excess: \$14,450.47

Budget Received: \$ 368,178.28 (Includes PPP Loan Transfers of \$65,943.06) Expenses: \$ 273,948.75

Excess: \$ 94,229.53

These numbers reflect the budget as it stood at the end of June. Some of the year to date surplus is due to the fact that we had the Payment Protection Plan loan, but much of it is due to the faithfulness of our church. We continue to see positive flow into our church coffers, and we have been able to make payments to our local missions as well as maintain our ongoing obligations. Those payments to the missions will continue as we monitor our budget during this COVID crisis.
