OUR CHURCH'S CHRISMON TREE

The Lutheran Church of the Ascension in Danville, Virginia pioneered the first "Chrismon" tree in 1957. The word "Chrismon" is a cross between Christ and Monogram. A Chrismon is a handmade ornament that proclaims the message of Christmas through symbolism. Al Martin, our former Minister of Music, took a group to Danville in 1977 to learn about Chrismons. With the help of Miheepa Jones of First United Methodist Church, our Chrismon ministry was born. For many years, we had live evergreen trees, but in recent years we have used an artificial tree. In January of 2020, we purchased a new Balsam Hill tree. Last year we were not able to have the Chrismon Tree due to the Pandemic, but this year we have our new tree adorned with dozens of new Chrismons that have been crafted in the past two years. In total, we have well over 300 beautiful, handmade Chrismons. On Sunday, December 5th, we will dedicate our new Chrismon tree.

BUDGET UPDATE

Budget Received: \$51,008.59

Expenses: \$ 45,886.89

Excess: \$5,121.70

Year to Date

2021 Projected Budget: \$ 709,303.00

Budget Received: \$557,043.83 (Includes PPP Loan Transfers of \$65,943.06)

Expenses: \$ 476,387.95

Excess: \$80,655.88

These numbers reflect the budget as it stood at the end of September. Some of the year to date surplus is due to the fact that we had the Payment Protection Plan loan, but much of it is due to the faithfulness of our church. We continue to see positive flow into our church coffers, and we have been able to maintain our ongoing obligations. We are pleased to report that we have fulfilled all of our mission obligations for this year. We are grateful to you all for continuing to remember the church!
