MARTHA BEST CHILDREN'S CENTER LEXINGTON, NC DIRECTOR POSITION OPENING ANNOUNCEMENT

The Martha Best Children's Center (MBCC) and First Baptist Church of Lexington, NC are seeking applicants for the position of Director of the facility. MBCC is a long established childcare facility with a history of quality childcare for children of Lexington and Davidson County, NC. MBCC provides full daycare services, after school care (Grades K-5) and a half-day nursery school (ages 2-5). The Director of MBCC would need to provide leadership of the programs and a staff of 25 people. The Director would be responsible for administrative duties, training and directing staff, and financial affairs with a yearly budget of \$600,000. A Bachelor's degree and leadership skills related to childcare are preferred. Prior childcare experience will be considered. An applicant must be able to complete the state required certification requirements for a childcare director and a complete background check. The salary range for the position is \$35,000 to \$41,000, plus benefits.
